PROCEDURE FOR HANDLING CONFLICTS

In case of life-threatening emergency, call 911.
To report non-emergency situations (dog injures another dog or individual; individual attacks a dog; stray dog found), call 651-458-2850.

If your dog is the aggressor:

- 1. Leash your dog and leave the park immediately.
- 2. If another patron is not comfortable with the way your dog is interacting with their dog, respect their request and move to another area of the park.
- 3. If your dog is just having a bad day, leave the park and try again another day.
- 4. The city will be notified of repeat offenders for appropriate action.
- 5. If your dog injures another dog, exchange contact information. You are liable for expense related to the injury.

If your dog is attacked:

- 1. If you encounter an aggressive dog, ask the patron to leave immediately.
- 2. If they refuse to leave, try to get their name or license plate number.
- 3. Report to the WAG Board at wfdpassoc@comcast.net or 651-368-8596. The city will be notified of repeat offenders.
- 4. If your dog is injured, you should call the police at **651-458-2850**, and hold the owner liable for injuries.
- 5. Report the incident to the WAG Board.
